Terms and Conditions

A. MCKL Alumni Discount Scheme

- 1. The Alumni Discount Scheme ("Scheme") is open to all alumni enrolling in any full time MCKL programme within two years of completion of the A Levels/ AUSMAT/ CAT/ ACCA FIA programme at MCKL. For the ACCA programme, alumni will be required to register for 3 Fundamental papers in the first semester of the Programme to be eligible for the Scheme.
- 2. Application for the Scheme must be submitted with the Programme Application Form, together with payment of the Application Fee and Admission Deposit.
- 3. Alumni who are scholarship holders are eligible for the Scheme save and except for alumni receiving 75% and above scholarships from MCKL or other parties.
- 4. The Scheme is not transferable or redeemable for cash or other monetary benefits.
- 5. Alumni who qualify for the Scheme will receive discounts reflected in the first and second semester invoices of the Programme, at RM 500.00 each.
- 6. MCKL reserves the right to revoke or change the terms and/or quantum of the Scheme at its sole and absolute discretion. MCKL's decision on all matters pertaining to the Scheme shall be final.

B. Bursary - Sibling or Selected High Schools/Home Schools Centres

- 1. The bursary is open to qualifying applicants below the age of 25 years enrolling in any fulltime MCKL programme within two years of completion of their SPM/ IGCSE. The bursary is not applicable to the ACCA programme.
- 2. Applicants for the Sibling Bursary must have a sibling who has completed or is currently completing a fulltime programme in MCKL. Sibling Bursary can only be awarded once per applicant throughout their studies at MCKL.
- 3. Application for the bursary must be submitted with the Programme Application Form, together with payment of the Application Fee and Admission Deposit.
- 4. Application for the bursary must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar before the end of the second week of the first semester, or within two weeks of the release of results, whichever is later. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 5. Applicants may apply for more than one MCKL scholarship/ bursary/ financial aid/ discount (collectively, "award") at any one time but will be permitted to benefit from only one award, which shall generally be the award with the highest quantum.
- 6. Recipients of the bursary are **required to pay the first semester fees in full** before the commencement of the semester. Bursary disbursement will commence from the second semester onwards.
- 7. The tuition fees coverage for the bursary is as follows:

Cambridge A Level	Maximum of 4 subjects	
Australian Matriculation	Maximum of 5 subjects	
American Degree Transfer Program	Maximum of 2 years or 65 cumulative credit hours, whichever comes first**	
ACCA FIA	Maximum 7 modules*	
Diploma Programmes	Maximum of 2.5 years or 90 cumulative credit hours, whichever comes first

- 7. Students who have not fully settled their semester fees are not entitled to any bursary disbursement in the subsequent semester.
- 8. The bursary will be disbursed on a semester-by-semester basis with the final disbursement upon the successful completion of the programme.
- 9. In the event a recipient is offered and accepts any scholarship, bursary, financial aid or other sponsorship for their MCKL studies from any other entity or person, (s)he shall inform the Office of the Registrar in writing within two (2) weeks of such acceptance. The Institution reserves the right to withdraw or adjust the quantum of the bursary to the recipient. Recipients who fail to inform the Office of the Registrar may face disciplinary action and/or be required to reimburse the value of the bursary to MCKL.
- 10. The bursary is not applicable to and does not cover:-
 - (i) Subjects/ Credit hours in which no examinations/assessments were attempted;
 - (ii) Withdrawn/ Dropped subjects; and
 - (iii) Repeat subjects/ papers.
- 11. This bursary is only valid for the duration of the enrolled programme and does not cover any extension of the programme beyond its minimum duration.
- 12. All bursary recipients are required to pass Service Learning and Character Formation subjects in order to maintain the bursary. However:
 - (i) ADTP students are not required to take Character Formation
- 13. The bursary may not be transferred to other MCKL programmes or deferred to other intakes except with the prior written consent of MCKL. Such consent may be withheld at MCKL's absolute discretion.
- 14. In the event that the recipient withdraws from the enrolled programme at any time after acceptance of the bursary (including prior to Programme commencement), any refund of fees is subject to the Terms and Conditions stated in the Student Handbook.
- 15. If the recipient is subject to disciplinary action, suspended or expelled from MCKL at any time before the completion of the Programme, the bursary shall terminate and be automatically revoked. MCKL reserves the right to require the recipient to reimburse the full value of the disbursed bursary in such events.
- 16. MCKL reserves the right to involve bursary recipients in various activities of the Institution, including interviews, MCKL events, education events, social media, photography/videos, and other promotional activities of MCKL.
- 17. The bursary is given at the sole discretion of MCKL. Applicants are not guaranteed approval of the bursary notwithstanding fulfilling the conditions set.
- 18. This bursary is not transferable or cannot be encashed and does not include external examination fees (if applicable) or textbooks.
- 19. MCKL reserves the right to amend any criteria and/or terms and conditions of the bursary at any time. The decision of MCKL on all matters pertaining to the bursary is absolute and final.
